Expressions of interest are invited from interested parties regarding the long term lease of the above building. The size of the building is approx. 8m x 8m. Refurbishment of the building would be required to bring it to an operational state, at the promoters cost, utilities to the building include water and electricity.

Expressions of interest must include the following details:

- Details of the proposed scheme/use of the building
- Detailed plans
- Sources of funding (if applicable)

Applicants should be mindful of any potential negative impact their scheme would have on the on the dunes and Coastal Erosion, and outline measures to mitigate these.

The scheme must provide access to public conveniences, and use of the building must be consistent with the Vesting Order (provision of Car Parks, Public Toilets and Ancillary works by way of amenities and services to promote the development of tourist traffic at Glenariffe, Waterfoot and to encourage persons residing elsewhere to visit the area).

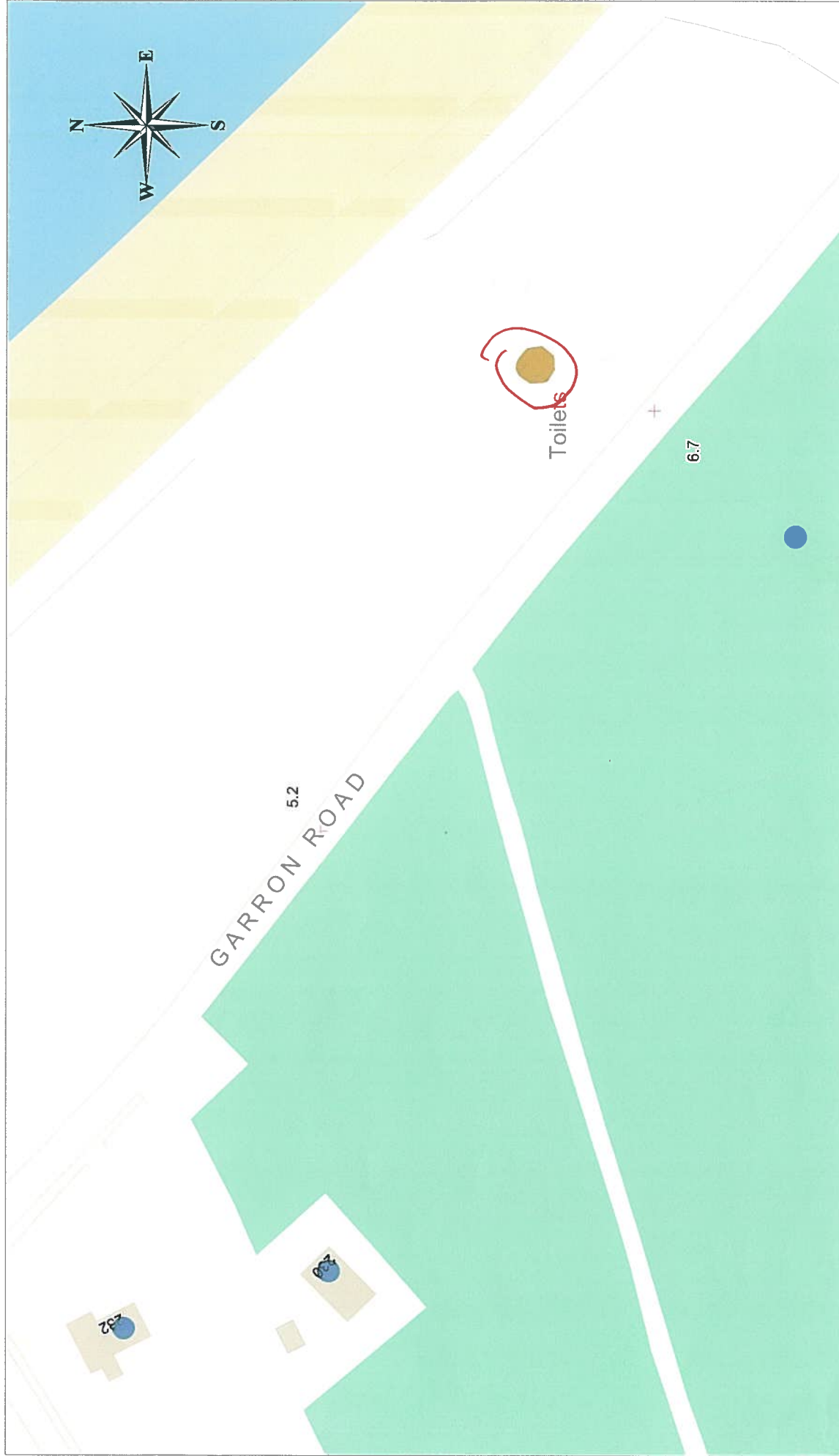
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Toilet Block Garron Road



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
